



EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 08

BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE PROVINCE OF CAGAYAN

WHEREAS, the Province of Cagayan was hit by super typhoon Lawin (Haima) on October 19, 2016, a category-5 tropical cyclone;

WHEREAS, super typhoon Lawin caused widespread destruction and substantial damage to property in the Province, with 74,672 affected families, 34,421 partially blown houses and 9,306 totally blown houses based on the PCCDRRMC Progress Report as of 8:00am of October 22, 2016 ;

WHEREAS, there are reports of overpricing/profitteering and hoarding of prime commodities, medicines and petroleum products;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has not yet acted on the recommendation of the PCCDRRMC for the declaration of state of calamity in the Province of Cagayan;

WHEREAS, promoting the welfare of the general public is foremost in the priorities of the provincial government;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, MANUEL N. MAMBA, Governor of the Province of Cagayan, in view of the foregoing, do hereby recognize the fact of a state of calamity in the Province of Cagayan.

All departments and other concerned offices are hereby directed to implement and execute rescue, relief, and rehabilitation work in accordance with pertinent operational plans and directives.

All departments and other concerned offices are also hereby directed to coordinate with, and provide or augment the basic services and facilities of affected municipalities and Tuguegarao City.

The provincial law enforcement agencies are hereby directed to undertake all necessary measures to ensure peace and order in affected areas, as may be necessary.
