EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26

REORGANIZING THE MUNIIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL OF CLAVERIA, CAGAYAN

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Local Government Units shall pursue undertakings too improve public morals and maintain peace and order, and to protect the life, liberty and property of the people, among other equality significant concerns;

WHEREAS, the increasing use of illegal drugs has significantly contributed to the rise of criminality which necessitate a more aggressive and unified stance against illegal drugs to help ensure community peace and order and harmony;

WHEREAS, this problem can be address if all efforts of concerns agencies are coordinated in the fight against drugs to eliminate, if not totally eradicate, the problem;

WHEREAS, DILG memorandum Circulars 98-227, 99-230, 2001-90, 2003-131, 2015-63 and DILG-DDB JMC 2018-01, direct all local government units to organize their respective Local Anti-drug Abuse Council, in furtherance of all government efforts to address the above-mentioned problem, and provide guidelines therefore;

WHEREAS, in view of the change of leadership in some member agencies, there is a need to reconstitute the membership of the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SOLFERINO A. AGRA, JR, MD by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council of Claveria, Cagayan, as provided hereunder:

SECTION I. COMPOSITION

The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall be constituted with the following composition:

SECTION II. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

1. Serve as the focal point through which various organizations and individuals work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;
2. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs and those which might be developed in the immediate future;
3. Provide a mechanism to obtain funds, volunteer facilities and technical expertise;
4. Conduct information and education campaign on the ill effects of illegal drugs, monitor and report to proper authorities, drugs pushers and drug pushers in the locality;
5. Prepare a confidential watch list of drug user and pushers found in the LGU's are of jurisdiction to be submitted to the PNP Anti—illegal Drugs Task Force for the latter's validation or verification leading to the arrest and filing of appropriate charges;
6. Perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by the competent authorities


SECTION III: MEETINGS

The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall meet at least once for every quarter or as often as deemed necessary.

SECTION IV: EFFECTIVITY

This order takes effect immediately.
